

## George Abbot School's Careers Programme

At George Abbot School careers education and guidance is a fundamental part of a student's education, acknowledging that students need to be informed regarding careers available to them, know how to gain access to them and how to manage their lifelong career.

Careers education features in PSE for every year group from Y7 - 11.

All students are guided at each transition stage by members of the school's senior leadership team. Equally, all students in the summer term of Year 10 or the autumn term of year 11 have the opportunity to have an interview with an external impartial careers advisor.
