## **Sixth Form students' next steps following A level and GCSE results days.**

I am writing to inform you of how your son/daughter can receive further support and guidance if they have any issues with their results which could affect their transition onto University, moving from Year 11 into the Sixth Form or from Year 12 into Year 13.

### Year 13 Students gaining entry to University

Following the A level results being released on Thursday 15 August, if students need further guidance and support with regards to entry to University or the clearing process, then the Sixth Form team and our Careers advisors, Ms Head, will be available on results day itself. Appointments can also be made on **Friday 16 August** or the morning of **Monday 19 August**. A sign-up sheet will be available from 10:00am in Raynham Hall on **Thursday 15 August**.

### Transition from Year 12 to Year 13

I am sure you will appreciate that Year 13 students will take priority after the A level results are released on **Thursday 15 August**. Students who we would like to meet with as a priority following the release of AS results will be contacted via telephone to book an appointment with the Sixth Form team for **Monday 19 August**.

If there are any other issues that students wish to discuss in person, then time has been allocated on the first week back of the academic year for Year 13 Signing On Day on Wednesday 4 September or a time on Thursday 5 or Friday 6 September. Lessons will start for all Sixth Form students on Monday 9 September.

### Transition from Year 11 to Sixth Form

Following the release of the GCSE results on **Thursday 22 August**, students will receive an email to confirm their place in the Sixth Form and that they have met the entry requirements for their chosen subjects. There will be also an online survey to complete to confirm their subject choices.

Students will be contacted on **Thursday 22 August**, via a Schoolcomms, if we need to discuss their entry into the Sixth Form with instructions of how to book an appointment for **Tuesday 27 August**.

If students wish to simply change a subject and have met the entry requirements for this subject then this can be done via the online survey mentioned above. These changes will then be confirmed on Year 12 Signing On Day on Wednesday 4 September. Students can also book an appointment to see a member of the Sixth Form team to discuss any further issues on this day on Thursday 5 or Friday 6 September. Lessons will start for all Sixth Form students on Monday 9 September.
