Headteacher's Message

19 March 2021

This week has seen the successful completion of all coronavirus testing for the school community. What a mammoth task! I hope you agree with me that the staff involved in the logistics and operation are George Abbot superstars of the highest order. Special thanks to Mrs Jones, Mr and Mrs Notley, Mr Rowland, Miss Jacobs, all of our Heads of Year and Sixth Form team. They have all been pivotal parts of the operation and managed large quantities of students calmly, safely and reassuringly. None of this could have happened, however, without our volunteers – you have been exceptional and we cannot thank you enough for giving of your time so generously.

By the end of today, all students will have come home from school with two packs of home testing kits. These will be for use in the last two weeks of term. Over the next two weeks, their Form Tutor will distribute a further two sets of lateral flow home testing kits for use over the Easter holidays. A reminder of the systems for registering your child's results are below.

At Home Testing

Please make sure your child tests themselves **twice a week, 3-5 days apart, in the morning before school if possible or the evening before**. Full guidance on how to take the test is included with the test kit.

Your child should also **continue testing twice a week, at home, throughout the Easter school holidays**.

It is really important that results of the test are reported online straight away, even if your child's result is negative or void. Please report the test results to:

Lessons across year groups have focused on recall and staff have been thoughtful and careful in their lesson planning as they have learnt more about where our students need to recap and revisit to consolidate strong understanding of the key curriculum content. We have been mindful that some of our students have been anxious and unsettled. We have reassured, given them opportunities to remember what they know and helped them to find the beginnings of a quiet confidence that their learning is on track.

I would like to highlight 4 events coming up in the next 9 school days:


- Year 9 Parents' Consultation appointments take place on Thursday 25 March – school will therefore close early at 1.30pm for all students.





Teacher's Fret
