| Organisation | <p>Task 1: imagine you are the curator of a photography exhibition with the title 'What is photography?'</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You can choose a number of images to represent your understanding of photography (minimum 10 images). These images can be any type/genre of photography from any time in the history of the medium. They could include documentary, fashion and/or art photography, amateur and professional. Create an imaginary exhibition of images in a sketch book or on paper. <p>Note: Try to be really creative about how you do this. For example, you could exhibit the images in a location, invite visitors, provide them a guide to the exhibition, produce relevant publicity materials, print a catalogue with accompanying text, create a video...etc.</p> <p>Examples of previous student work can be found at the bottom of the following link: https://www.photopedagogy.com/what-is-photography1.html</p> <p>Task 2: take 26 photographs, one for each letter of the alphabet, be inventive.
