Headteacher's Message

10 September 2021

All

The end of the first full week of term always sees a collective deep breath as we all remember the energy and focus that school requires alongside the general on our toes-ness. This week has seen Round Two of LFTs – brilliant job, team LFT; photographs – more lining up and immaculate organisation; first assemblies and working out where to sit and indeed, remembering the alphabet; Year Group Information Evenings for Years 7, 8 & 9 – thank you to all of the parents and carers who were able to join us; school musical auditions which saw over 140 students audition to be involved in our show – Little Shop of Horrors; locating of lessons for our intrepid Year 7s and the location assistance provided by staff and older students alike as we have attempted to describe how to locate mysterious staircases in Elmslie or seemingly non-existent DT classrooms in Raynham. Very importantly, it has also seen our 2021 Year 13 Prom – finally taking place in truly glamorous and joyful style and a special event to treasure as our young people celebrated 7 successful years at George Abbot. It has been a busy and happy school.

I spoke to our students about the importance of paying attention to detail in this week's assemblies. I asked them to apply this key skill to their lessons, their uniform, their homework, their choice of words and to their attitude. In response, student conduct across the school has been exceptional and lessons have been full of interested and active learners. We have been supported by some beautiful sunny days and the opportunity to get involved in lots of extra-curricular activities and spend time with friends. School is feeling good. That said, we have had a number of positive cases across year groups, though we do not yet have 5 within a group of close contacts (e.g. a Form Group) – a recommended trigger for further measures within the government's Contingency Guidance, alongside a benchmark of cases in 10% of the school population. These two triggers are significantly different numbers when applied in a school as large as ours. However, I am monitoring case numbers across all years very carefully and in particular, in Year 7. Our local Public Health England team continue to support Headteachers in deciding if additional measures need to be reintroduced – I will keep you fully apprised. Current COVID-19 case numbers are:

Year 7 = 8 (across tutor groups)

Year 8 = 0

Year 9 = 2

Year 10 = 0

Year 11 = 1

Year 12 = 0

Year 13 = 3

Next week sees another beginning of term essential – we will hold a **Fire Drill on Friday 17 September at 10.40am**. Students will be informed that this is a drill and staff will prepare students so that unnecessary panic is avoided and calm building evacuation is accomplished. Students in Years 7-11 have been offered the **Nasal Flu immunisations** which are taking place on **Monday 12 September and Tuesday 13 September**. We also continue with our sequence of Parents' Information Evenings:

Year 10 – Wednesday 15 September, 6.00-7.00pm Raynham Hall

Year 11 – Thursday 16 September, 6.00-7.00pm Raynham Hall

⇒ Detention Day Change

Please note, this year, detentions for students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will be centralised on a Thursday after school in Elmslie Hall. You will be notified of the detention on Monday via email and students will be reminded in form time on Tuesday. We will be enforcing the expectation for students to bring work to complete, or a book to read, during the Thursday detentions. We believe that this will ensure they are using their time in detention productively. Refusal to work will only compound the situation students already find themselves in.

⇒ School Uniform Update Opening Times and Ordering

The school shop will continue to open this term by appointment. This is partly to avoid overcrowding as it's small and has no ventilation, and partly because we have had positive feedback from parents/carers that with an appointment there aren't queues and very little waiting time. It also gives us the flexibility to open on different days each week.

If you know what you need we can arrange to take payment over the phone and you, or your son/daughter can collect without an appointment. To do this, please email as at the same email address and use the header line 'GA SHOP ORDER'. Please include your son or daughter's name, the item you need and the size you need. Add in your phone number and we'll call you back to take card payment by phone. We will then tell you our next opening times and you may collect without an appointment.

If you leave a message on the school shop number we will call you back, but the process is likely to be slower than if you email us or call our office on the above number.

Stock Availability

Like many retailers we continue to experience delays to some deliveries owing to bottlenecks in the supply chain. For anyone with orders placed with us and paid for, we will text you as soon as your item arrives with details of when we are open for collections.

We now have a stock of leggings in most sizes. We expect to take delivery of track trousers imminently. The 1/4 zip tops are expected to arrive in the next 2-3 weeks although this is subject to confirmation.
