Headteacher's Message

As the first three Advent calendar windows have been opened, we have been treated to the wonder of George Abbot's Little Shop of Horrors. I have sneaked some glimpses but am due to attend this evening; comments from those who have enjoyed the show this week indicate that those of us anticipating 7pm are going to be impressed – 'so, so, so good' and 'the show was fantastic' are a small sample. We have some seriously talented actors, dancers, singers and musicians; both they, all those students involved in production and the staff who have pulled this off, despite COVID-19 absences doing their best to derail us, are frankly, a dream team. I am so proud of each of them.

Also this week, an important celebration of two girls sports teams. Our Year 10 girls basketball team are now the crowned Guildford District champions and our Year 8 girls football side won this week's local Guildford 5-a-side tournament. Extremely good news – despite appearances, which can be deceptive, I am seriously competitive when it comes to sport and victories matter – well done to all those girls involved – you have represented GAbbot brilliantly.

Next a quick overview of the run up to the end of term:

- Monday 6 December – students are asked to bring in a donation for the PTA raffle – they should bring their donation to their tutor rooms at 8.30am. Triple House Points are our way of thanking them for remembering!
- Monday 6 December – Year 7 and 8 parents' coffee morning – 9.00-10.00am, Elmslie Hall. Do come along to this PTA event and meet some of your fellow year group parents/carers.
- Monday 6 December – early closure for Year 7 Parent Subject Consultations – 1.30pm.
- Tuesday 7 December – Friday 17 December inclusive – Year 11 internal assessments.
- Tuesday 7 December – COVID-19 vaccinations for Year 8 and Year 9 – students to wear house shirts.
- Friday 10 December – Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day – please donate via WisePay for this important charity – especially to make a difference to the most vulnerable this Christmas.
- Friday 10 December – school closure at 1.00pm. Student leaders and musicians/dancers involved have already received a letter regarding the arrangements. All other students, parents/carers, relatives and staff are warmly invited – a time and place to come together as one George Abbot community is rare, so if you are able to join us, it would be VERY good to see you there – 2.00pm start.
- Tuesday 14 December – final bulletin of the term.
- Friday 17 December – mufti day – £2 donation to go towards school PTA funds – there will be a donation button on WisePay.
- Friday 17 December – school closes at 12.00pm.

As per my email of earlier this week, we will be lateral flow testing all students at the beginning of the Spring Term – the date for Year 13 is now finalised as the afternoon of Wednesday 5 January and all other year groups will start school at set times throughout the day on Thursday 6 January. Apologies again that this might mean you need to sort out alternative travel arrangements if your child usually travels by school bus. Please check your home supplies of lateral flow testing kits – we will be handing out more at the gate over the coming days, but your child is also welcome to collect some from their Head of Year or from Elmslie Office. Lastly, a reminder that there have been recent changes in the Government's rules around taking a PCR test upon arrival to the UK on return from travel overseas. This must therefore be factored into arrival dates back to the UK ensuring enough time for the PCR result to be returned to you before your children are due to start the new term.

At this point, we continue to have relatively low COVID-19 case numbers, but I am really grateful for your support in encouraging your children to follow the recommendation regarding mask wearing in communal spaces. We continue to do all we can to keep our George Abbot community safe. This week's COVID-19 numbers are:
