## Headteacher's Message

The new term has already brought a daily burst of updates from the government regarding COVID-19 and the consequent expectations of or guidelines for schools. We will continue to do our best to communicate these to our community as clearly as we can.

Today's DfE update asks for masks to be voluntary for all internal examinations. We have immediately adjusted our arrangements accordingly.

Thank you to all parents and carers for supporting school in the prompt testing of 2000 students so that term could get underway with all students in lessons today. Our army of testing volunteers had a really tough and exhausting day. We are so very grateful for their commitment to our community. Students too were superb in waiting patiently. Testing instructions for school require that they are tested before they return to lessons. The rapidity with which the Omicron variant can spread meant that we kept students in the fresh air as much as we could. We picked up a number of positive LFT results and so this approach was the safest in terms of the transmission of COVID-19 at the beginning of an important academic term.

Below is a reminder of the main COVID-19 guidance changes as they stand today. Please particularly note the upcoming change regarding PCR tests which take effect from Tuesday 11 January.

## COVID-19 Government Guidance

### Facemasks

"We are already taking targeted and proportionate action by recommending face coverings for all adults in the **communal areas** of all settings, and for **pupils and students in Year 7 and above** in communal areas. And from Tuesday 4 January, we also recommend that face coverings should be **worn in classrooms** and teaching spaces where students in Year 7 and above are educated. The advice is short term only and will be reviewed on 26 January, in line with the review on Plan B measures."

### Confirmatory PCR tests to be temporarily suspended for positive lateral flow device (LFD) test results

"Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test."

### Vaccinations

"**Vaccinations** remain our best defence against COVID-19 and that is why every child and young person aged 12 and over is eligible to receive the vaccine. It is also vital that all of us – including parents, carers, teachers, early years professionals, eligible students and everyone working in education and childcare – go out as soon as they possibly can to get the **booster jab**, to protect the NHS, protect our way of life, and protect education and childcare."



### Following a positive COVID-19 test result

"Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. **If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education or childcare setting from day 7.** Please refer to the diagram below from the Government website."

This work will be set via Satchel One and/or the SLE.</p> <p>Provision has been made for students who are unable to go home at this time.
