Headteacher's Message

Two important things from me today. First, an enormous well done to the 150 students who participated in our Spring Celebration of music and dance. It was a triumphant end to the term. We were treated to beautiful dance routines and music spanning the ages—from 1700 to the present day. The vocal standards were exceptional with a particular highlight being the joyful rendition of a medley from the musical Matilda, showcasing our Year 7 choir alongside our senior students. The orchestra and concert band demonstrated the depth of musical talent amongst our students, posing a significant challenge to fit everybody onto Raynham stage. George Abbot Male Voice Choir were immense, as ever...not many state secondary schools can boast a choir of such quality. Individual students absolutely shone in a range of small ensemble performances and I know that there were many proud family members in attendance. Thank you so much to the Performing Arts staff for staging such a joyful event.

Secondly, the Summer Term will see a focus on the George Abbot Character Education programme. Ensuring our students are well equipped with both academic and personal skills requires deliberate care and thought. It is important to note that supervised student places are more limited than in previous times due to COVID-19 restrictions, so it is vital that we are forewarned of those who will be in attendance.

If you notify us your child will be remaining in school and your arrangements change, it is essential you let us know of the change before 12.00pm on the day. Where we have been notified that a student will be remaining in school, if they fail to arrive and register at USIC, you will be contacted by a truancy call alert from our attendance system. Therefore, it is important they register in USIC at 2.15pm if you have notified us that your son/daughter is remaining in school. **Please be reminded school buses will run at the usual time.**
