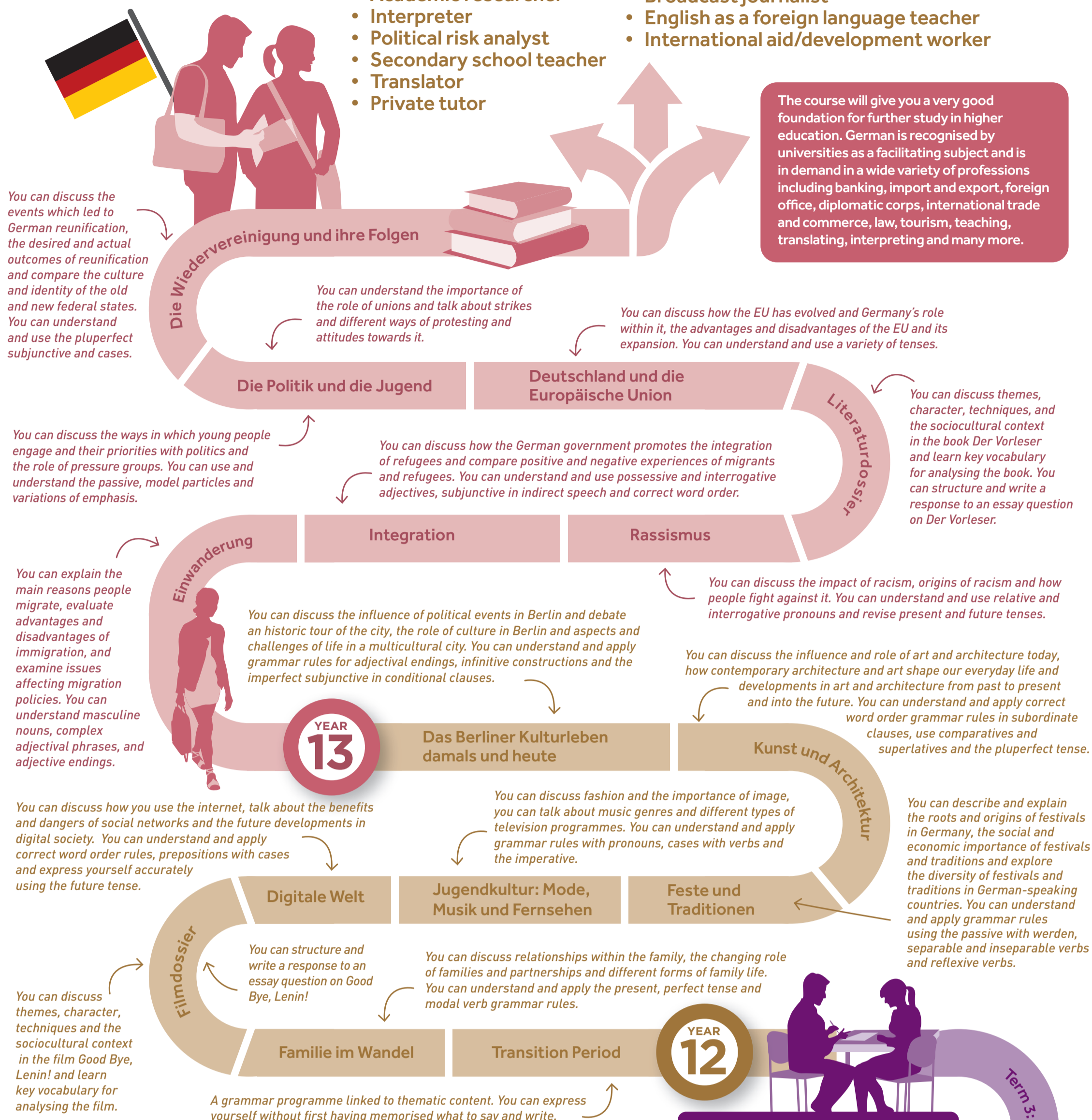


What can I do with German qualifications?
